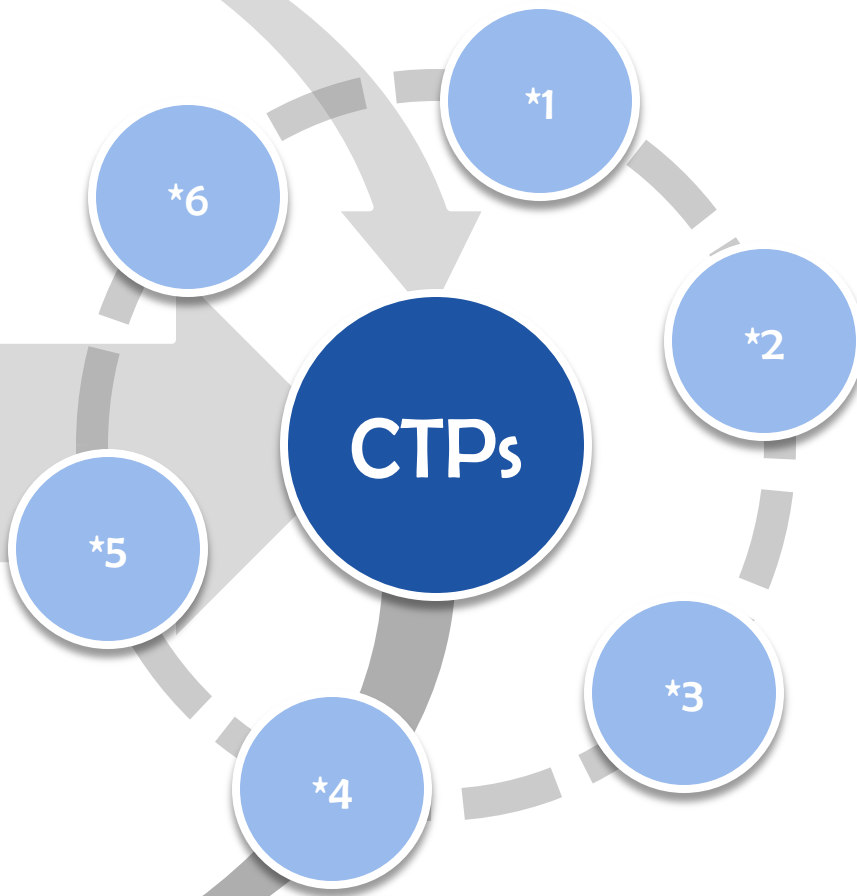

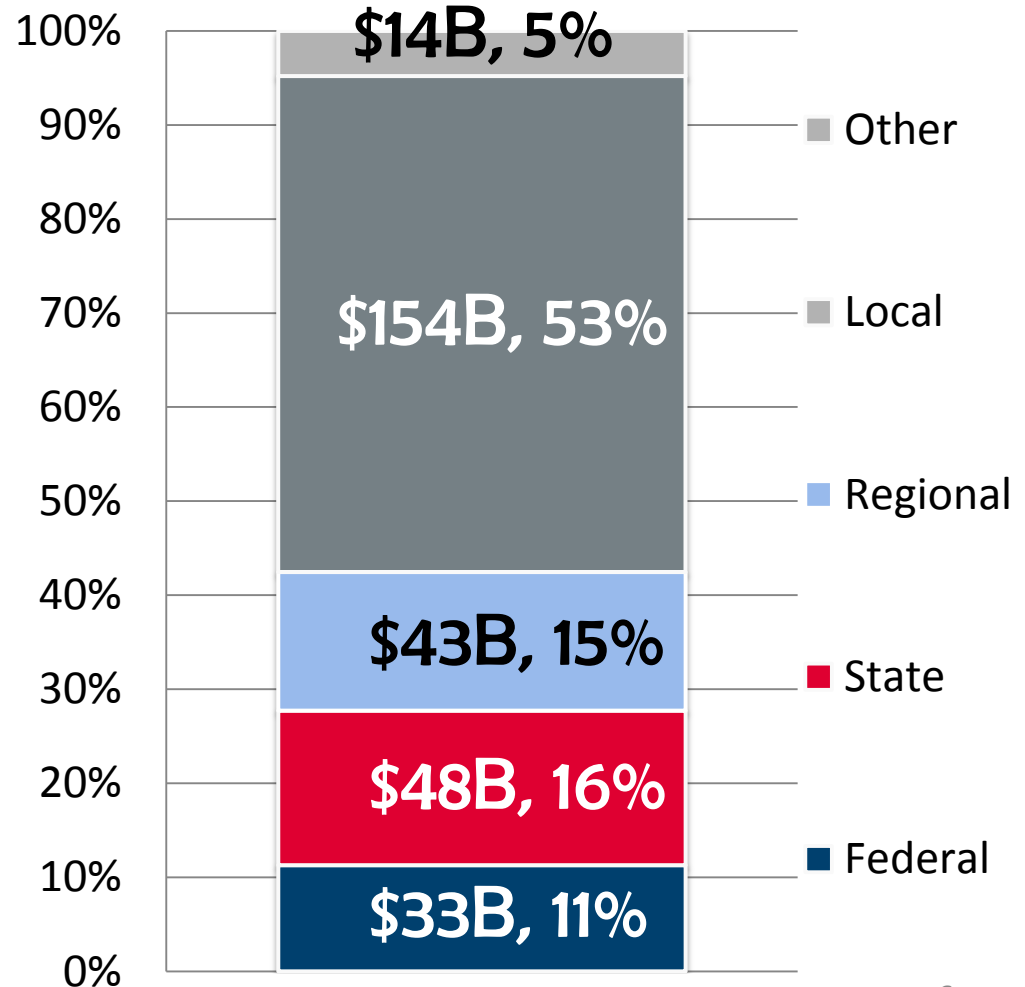

Context

CMAAs planning and funding responsibilities are many

28- Year Revenue Forecast



Law

- Government Code Section 66531
- “Primary Basis” for the RTP
- Developed with participation from the cities and transit operators
- Recommended transportation improvements for the succeeding 10- and 20-year periods

Content

- Recommendations for investments
- Consideration of transportation system and demand management strategies
- Consideration of transportation impacts associated with land use
- Consideration of strategies that conserve existing transportation system capacity
- Consideration of expected transportation revenues

Existing Guidelines

- Developed 1995, updated in 2000 in Resolution 2120
- Key Sections
 - Intro/Legislation
 - CTPs and the RTP
 - CTP Content
 - Preparation and Submission to MTC

Objectives

- Align guidelines with new federal, state and local planning requirements (e.g. SB 375)
- Balance local priorities and processes with regional needs
- Seek opportunities to consolidate planning efforts (e.g. CMP)

*Plan Bay Area

Approved July 2013 by the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) and by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC)

*Bay Area 2010 Clean Air Plan

Approved September 2010 by the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD)
