Hi Dave, I think things are going well. The Plan and EIR must be a big lift.

A couple of informational questions for reviewing the Plan and the EIR:

Where would I find project cost breakdowns within the Strategies. For example, Strategy T11--Expand and modernize the regional rail network--has multiple projects within it. I'd like to see the cost numbers for each.

I've asked you a version of this question before, but I'll ask it in this context. Are there breakdowns--other than on the maps--for subcounty areas of projected housing and employment growth? I'm thinking of cities, PDAs, even maybe Census Tracts or TAZs. It would be good to get more of a handle on where this growth is projected.

Just one example--are all of the Berkeley Hills included in growth geographies? I don't think they're all within a 1/2 mile of frequent bus service.
