Thanks for the question. At this point, the approved Plan Bay Area 2050 Growth Pattern only includes official projections on the county and subcounty ("superdistrict") levels, as you have found.

I can help you with the 2015 household counts if that helps – we typically use DOF’s counts for these totals.
