I'm a land use attorney who lives in Alameda County and works in Contra Costa. I've been a dedicated cyclist for many years and would be thrilled if the MTC and Caltrans would open the Richmond Bridge to cyclists and pedestrians via its 2015 Transportation Improvement Program. The ability to cross the Bay via a relatively central bridge would open hundreds of new routes to local cyclists, including the ability to ride to and from SF via the Golden Gate. With the opening of the Bay Bridge western span path many years off, a link via the Richmond Bridge would prove a crucial, real-time connection that would serve a wide swath of both agencies' constituents.
